We will convene at 6:30 to visit, followed by dinner at 7 pm. Risto Marttinen has kindly offered to speak to us about the Winter War, which took place between Finland and Russia, beginning in 1939. It is an amazing story when one considers the odds in a conflict between countries the size of Finland and Russia. Risto's father played a major role and we will hear more about that. The cost is \$30 per person, same as last year. This is the base price before service fee and tax which generally runs \$8 to \$10 extra. SHSKY will absorb the cost beyond \$30 for paid members and their guests. Cost of annual membership is \$25 per single individual and \$30 for families. 
DESSERT Crème Brule Greta Thunberg, the 16 year old founder of school strikes to protest lack of progress of leaders of the world in addressing climate change has been nomininated for the Nobel Peace Prize for her work. Greta caught the attention, interest and support of young people around the world. Her lone protest outside of the Swedish Parliament in addressing climate change resulted in school strikes in approximately 1,659 cities and towns in 105 countries last Friday. Young people are more engaged and dedicated than ever, as seen following the shooting at Parkland High School in Florida. Regardless of one's politics, it is heartening to see their engagement and dedication to taking on the most difficult problems.

If you are looking for a fascinating read, you might consider, <u>The Ghost Ships of Archangel</u>, by William Geroux. It is the story of one of the merchant marine conveys from this country that carried supplies to Russia during WW II. For reasons explained, an admiral in London ordered the convoy dispersed, upon which the British protectors left, with one exception. A few of the ships went into the ice pack to avoid detection and to try to make it to Russia.
